# NORSK IN AMERICAN PRO SPORTS

Norwegians are not common on American pro sports teams, but there have been some. The Sports Illustrated Magazine of April 22 listed the most accomplished Norsk in each major sport. In the National Basketball Assn., Torgeir Bryn of Oslo played 10 minutes for the Clippers in 1989, scored 4 points and committed 5 fouls. In the National Hockey League, Kjell Espen Knutsen of Oslo played four seasons with the Blue Jackets hockey team from 2000 on. There have been 7 Norskies in the National Hockey League. In baseball, there have been 4 Norwegians in Major League Baseball. The best was John Anderson of Sarpsborg who played 14 seasons, and led the majors with 22 triples and a .494 slugging percentage in 1898. In the National Football League Jan Stenerud was well known. He came from Fetsund and played 19 seasons with the Chiefs, Packers, and (appropriately) the Vikings. He is one of only 3 placekickers in the Hall of Fame, and scored 1,699 points. He's the only Norwegian ever to play in that league.
